

Following my interview with the Dutch Parliamentary committee on the follow up of the safety investigation of MH17, below please find the answers to questions from the parliamentarians to which I promised an answer before Wednesday.

**Were we aware of any issues in the eastern part of Ukrainian airspace, e.g. reduced capacities etc. due to radar interference or other such events.**

I can confirm that we did not receive any such information.

**What airlines stopped flying in eastern Ukraine following the airspace restrictions in the Crimea region?**

The following airlines:

- Norwegian Air Shuttle AS
- Srilankan Airlines
- Scandinavian Airlines System
- Thomson Airways LTD

operated regular flights through Eastern Ukraine until April 2014 but, according to our records, did not operate any flight through the same airspace as of 1<sup>st</sup> May.

The following airlines:

- British Airways
- Kharkiv Airlines
- Pegasus Hava Tasimaciligi A.S. (Pegasus)
- Finnair OYJ

operated very few flights through Eastern Ukraine in May 2014 and no flights in June and July.
